The month of March saw the Public Works crew spending days working on the following projects:

- 5 days flushing frozen culverts
- 4 days plowing after 6 events
- 2 days clearing sidewalks
- 3 days truck/equip maintenance after storms
- 4 loads of trash hauled to JRL
- 16 days patching potholes/ filling frost heaves
- 3 days spent receiving road salt
- 3 days spent on Town Dock float maintenance

This continues to be an exceptional year so far for frost heaves. Big fluctuations in temperature have caused havoc with frost heaves this year in abnormal places. As a result, the local roads were "posted" on the 11th of March until April 30th.
